

2009 PRESIDENT'S AWARD

Nomination Form

The President's Award recognizes the efforts of a service unit team, geographic area team or program delivery team in moving its assigned area or audience toward achievement of the council's goals during the current or previous membership year.

Criteria:

1. All team members are registered members of Girl Scouts of the USA.
2. All team members have completed appropriate training, or demonstrated competence, or both, for the positions they hold.
3. Delivery of Girl Scout program to the Girl Scout service unit/area/audience is effective, resulting in the retention of 75% of the Girl and Adult troop /group members.
4. Overall girl membership for the area or audience has reached or surpassed the membership goal agreed upon by the team and the Council.
5. The composition of the team reflects the diversity of the Girl Scout Service Unit, area or audience. (Diversity includes: gender, age, different abilities, religious/spiritual affiliation, ethnic/racial background, etc.)
6. Team members cultivate contacts in the community, such as through scheduled talks to civic groups, sponsorship agreements, or community profile updates.
7. Council-required reports are submitted on time.
8. The team maintains ongoing communications with each troop/group and with leaders utilizing a variety of methods (meetings, mail, telephone, etc.) that serve the needs of area adults.
9. The team maintains ongoing communications with girls registered as individually registered Girl Scouts.
10. The team encourages adult participation in the Family Partnership campaign and has reached or surpassed the service unit fund development goal agreed upon by the team and the Council.

President's Awards are presented at the Annual Meeting. The honored team's name is engraved on the President's Award plaque displayed in the Tampa Service Center. The team also receives a President's Award certificate.
