WHAT DO WINNERS RECEIVE?

Each qualified National winner receives:

- » a trip to attend the Bank of America Technology Showcase and Awards Ceremony, held in Charlotte, North Carolina in March of 2010
- » an engraved award for both the student and the student's school

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- » Applicants must be high-school level girls (grades 9-12).
- » Applicants should have a demonstrated outstanding aptitude and interest in IT/computing, and demonstrated leadership ability.
- » Applicants should have good academic history, typically a GPA of 3.0 or better.
- » Applicants should have post-secondary education plans.
- » Minority students and current Juniors/Seniors are strongly encouraged to apply.
- » Past applicants including runners-up are encouraged to apply, however, previous award-winners are not eligible to reapply or receive any awards.
- » Relatives of employees or board members of NCWIT and/or Bank of America are prohibited from receiving the National award. Relatives of employees of Bank of America are eligible for the Affiliate award.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Visit www.ncwit.org/award. Applications open on October 1, 2009 for the 2010 National award call. Applicants have until November 15, 2009 to complete their application. Email any questions to aspirations@ncwit.org.

NEW THIS YEAR – AFFILIATE AWARDS
