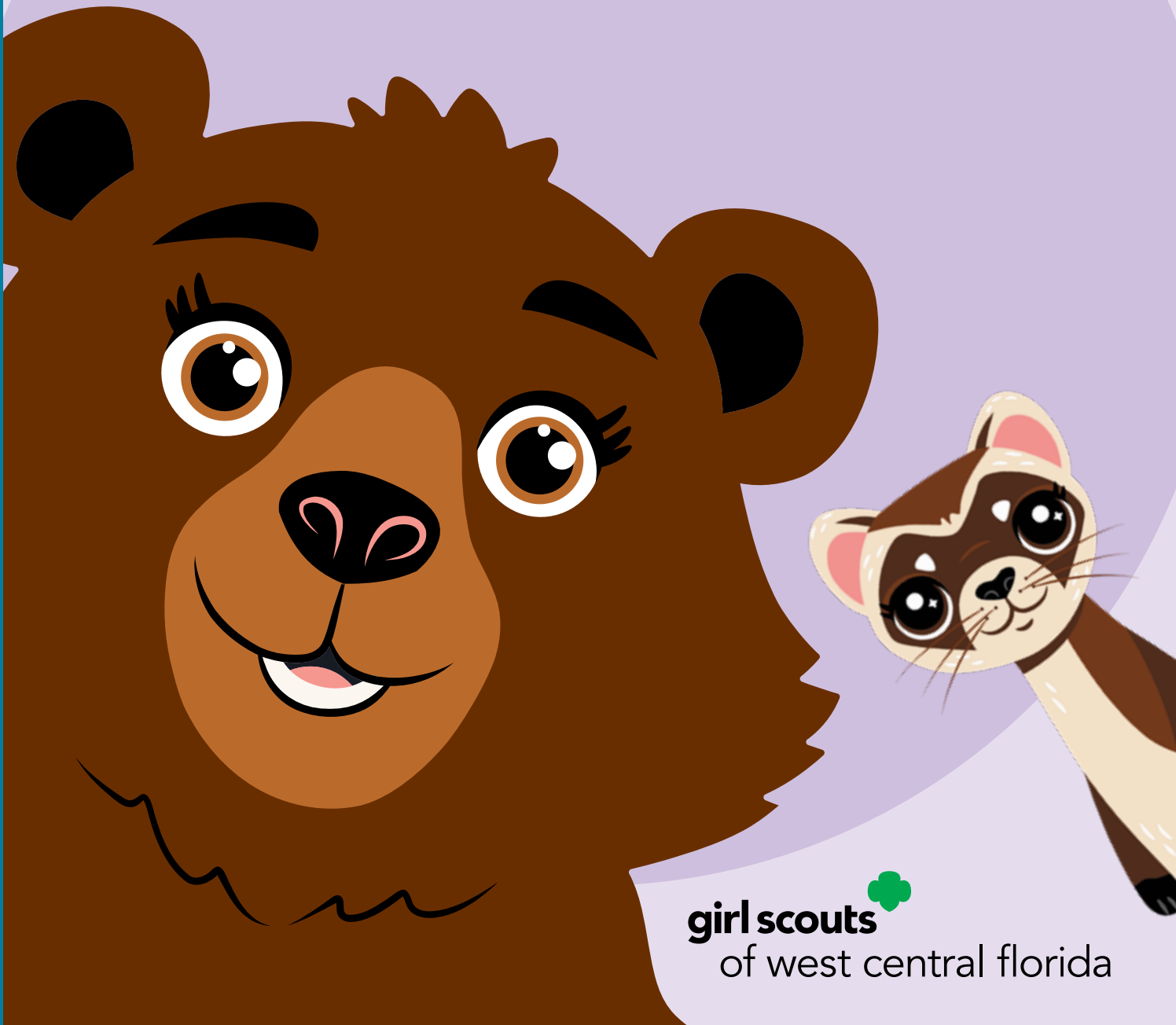

In this guide you will see the rewards that Girl Scouts have the opportunity to earn if they participate in Girl Scouts of West Central Florida, (GSWCF) Sweets & Treats Fall Product Program or GSWCF Girl Scout Cookie Season.

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Dear Girl Scout family,

The Sweets & Treats Fall Product Program is a friends and family sale that takes place from late September through November. As girls sell sweets and treats including nuts, chocolates, magazine subscriptions and other items-they'll build self-esteem. They'll also learn how to set goals, budget costs, create a marketing plan, and then go out and make it all happen!

Sweets & Treats is the beginning platform of the Girl Scout Entrepreneurial Program through which girls begin developing five essential skills:

- goal setting
- decision making
- money management
- people skills
- business ethics

Your Girl Scout will use the skills she learns in this program throughout her lifetime. The program enables troops to earn funds while having fun at the beginning of the Girl Scout year, and gives family and friends the opportunity to support Girl Scouting in their community. One hundred percent of the Sweets & Treats proceeds stay within our council!

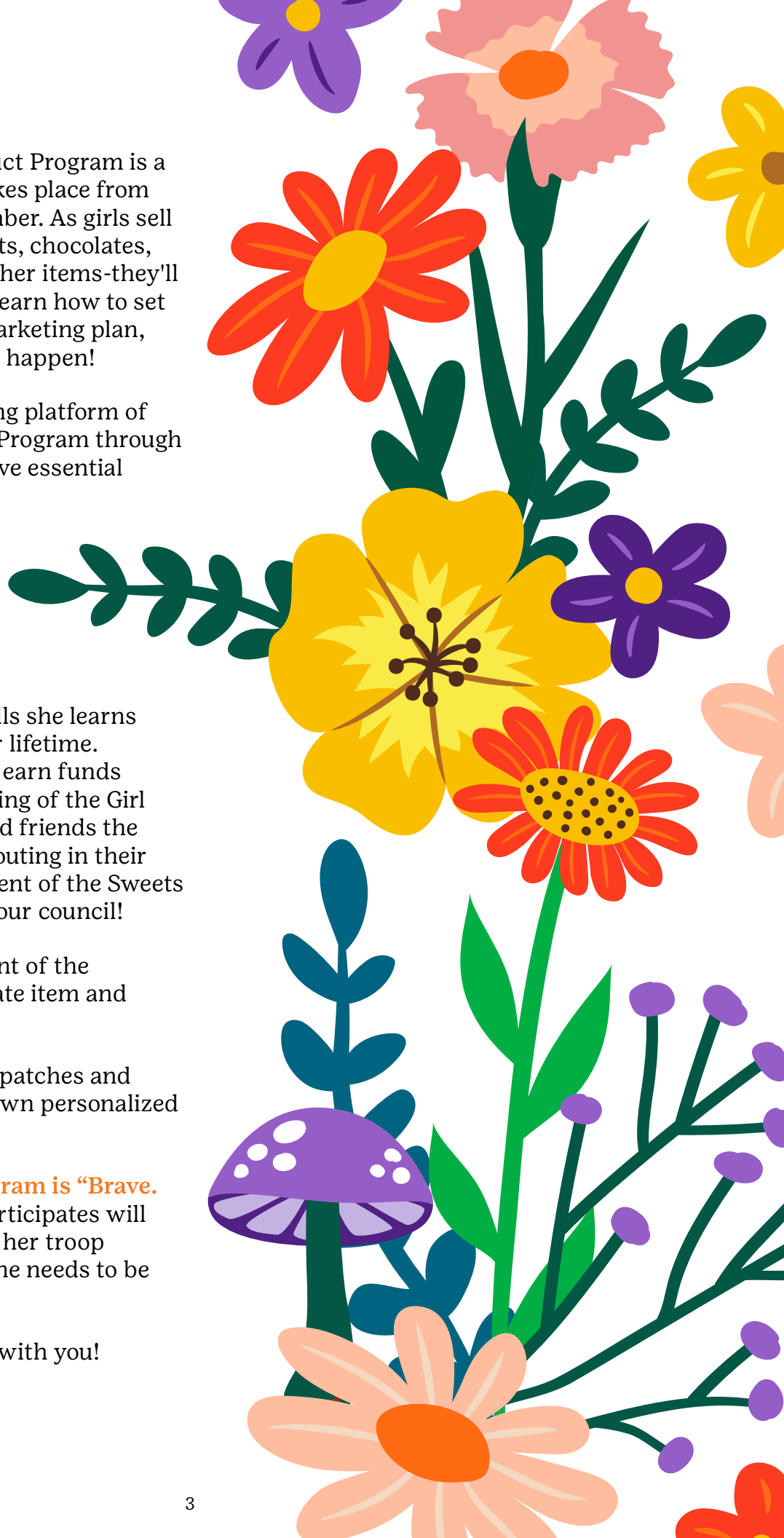
Girl Scout troops earn 15 percent of the proceeds for every nut, chocolate item and magazine sold.

In addition, girls can earn cool patches and rewards, including their very own personalized avatar patch.

The theme for this year's program is "Brave. Fierce. Fun!" Each girl who participates will receive a program packet from her troop leader containing everything she needs to be successful.

Meet this year's 2025 Fall Mascot

Grizzly Bears

Scientific name: *Ursus arctos horribilis*

2025 Fall Sweets & Treats Rewards

When Girl Scouts participate in the Sweets & Treats Fall Product Program (see our [Volunteer/Caregiver guide](#) for details), they have the opportunity to earn rewards by selling nuts, chocolates, and other items available through the online storefront (M2). This year within GSWCF Sweets & Treats Fall Product Program, Girl Scouts can earn rewards based on the dollar amount sold instead of items sold.

Example: Girl Scouts sell three BarkBoxes at \$28.99 and one Winter Wilderness Tin Peppermint bark rounds at \$14.00, The girl Scout has already earned above the first level.

Physical Rewards

Rewards such as patches, a bandana, and plush will be shipped directly to your Service Unit Fall Product Manager (SUFPM), who will then distribute them to troop leaders. Estimated shipping is late November to early December. Any changes will be communicated through your SUFPM.

Events & Council Dough

- Reward emails are sent directly to the caregiver email listed in M2. Add girlscoutswcf@email.girlscouts.org to your contacts to avoid missing them. (Check spam/junk/promotions folders if you don't see them.)
- Initial "congratulations" emails for earners begin in early November. Events occurring sooner will have emails sent out first. Each earned event will have its own email.
- Most events hosted or coordinated by GSWCF require caregivers to complete a JotForm with additional details.

Event Guidelines

- GSWCF reward events are for the registered Girl Scout earner and one adult chaperone.
- GSWCF cannot accommodate Tag-alongs unless the reward specifically allows the Girl Scout to bring a registered K-12 Girl Scout friend with an active membership.
- For events hosted by third-party locations, extra tickets for additional chaperones or family members must be purchased directly from the host. GSWCF does not provide or coordinate extra tickets. Purchased tickets may not include the same perks, seating, or arrangements as GSWCF reward earners. Event tickets cannot be transferred to other dates or members.

Council Dough

Council Dough emails will be sent in late December or early January, informing families of what their Girl Scout has earned.

Care to Share*

5+ Care to Share Items

The Care to Share program allows
customers to donate nut items to
military overseas and local food relief
organizations. The donation can be made
on the order card or online. Each Care to
Share item is \$7. The product program
department facilitates delivery of all
Care to Share items.



- Girls who sell five Care to Share items will receive the Care to Share patch.
- Girls who sell 15 Care to Share items will receive the patch and \$10 in Council Dough.

Troop Bonus

Online Patch & \$10 per girl per troop*

Girl Scouts can earn \$10 for her troop
and the online patch by selling 5 or
more online items sold by 10/12 in
the M2 system.



- Online items are ordered and paid for online through M2 system.
- Troops must meet troop minimum requirements by 10/12 for bonus.**
- Troop bonus will be deposited by ACH on 10/31.***
- Patch will arrive with other physical rewards and patches.

*Troop is defined as 5+girls with three selling and at least one unrelated. See online volunteer/caregiver guide for more information.

**Troops must meet the have a minimum of five girls registered, with three girls participating and at least one of whom is unrelated.

***Troops without troop bank info given by 10/20 will have troop bonus ACH deposited into SU bank account that SU Accounting Coordinators will transfer when account is opened.

Personalized Patches*

Earn these two special patches with your name and avatar on them.

How girl scouts earn a Fall Personalized Patch with her avatar.

- She creates her avatar
- Sends 18+ unique customer emails through the M2 system
- Sells 4+ Mags & More items and 40+ nut/chocolate items

*Patches go into production when the girl earns it and normally arrive in 6-8 weeks, mailed directly from vendor using the address entered in the M2 system.



Cookie Crossover Patch*

Girl Scouts can earn a Cookie Crossover Personalized patch by doing the following:

- Creates her avatar in M2 system
- Sends 18+ unique customer emails and sells 15+ items during the Sweets & Treats Program.
- Sells 350 packages of cookies during the 2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program

*Production of the cookie crossover patches start after the end of cookie season normally arrive mid-July. These are mailed by the vendor directly to the Girl Scout using the address the caregiver entered in the M2 system.



Volunteer Patch*

Troop Fall Product Managers can earn their personalized patch.

- Troop volunteer will earn a Personalized Patch if the troop reaches \$1,900 of total sales and send out the Parent Adult Email Campaign.
- Remember to create your avatar in the M2 system.

*Patches go into production for volunteers after girl patches are produced, normally mid-January.

Rewards are cumulative. Rewards are earned individually, per participant, per product program season. Reward choices can be made online once a participant sets up their online campaign site. Rewards are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances, and similar items might be used as a substitute. Some items may vary in color.

GSWCF Girl Reward Credits

Girl Scouts who participate in the **Sweets & Treats Fall Product Program** can earn a variety of GSWCF-specific, unique rewards. Visit gswcf.org/fpp for the full list of rewards that girls can earn. Please also review the order card to learn more about the different levels and opportunities.

GSWCF Council Dough*

GSWCF Council Dough can be used to:

- Register for GSWCF programs and events at gswcf.org/events.
- Participate in GSWCF summer camp or service unit encampments.
- Pay for GSWCF service unit events (let the event organizer know your Girl Scout wants to use her Council Dough).
- Purchase Girl Scout merchandise at GSWCF's store or trading posts (not online at this time).
- Renew your Girl Scout's membership.
- Assist with Girl Scout's GSUSA destination expenses or travel conducted with EF Tours or Explorica (submit a request to info@gswcf.org for details).



Council Dough expires two years after being awarded (i.e., Council Dough awarded in 2025 will expire Sept. 30, 2027). To request a balance for any of these credits, caregivers can contact Customer Care at info@gswcf.org or 813-281-4475.

*GSWCF rewards are designed for the Girl Scouts who earned them and are not transferable. Reward experiences cannot be transferred to another Girl Scout or Troop. Reward credits are for GSWCF redemption and not transferable to another Girl Scout council for use. No alternative credits are given after selections are submitted to GSWCF.

*For program/events purchased with Council Dough, GSWCF will provide refunds of the reward credits if the purchased event is canceled by Council, or a caregiver requests a refund before the cancellation policy deadline.

Juliette Council Credits for Fall

Juliette's (IRG) earn rewards at the reward levels as well as Council credit. Council Credit gets earned using the following chart below. **Due to IRS regulations Juliette Girl Scouts do not earn troop proceeds, they earn council credits based on the number of items sold.** GSWCF Council Credit can be used same as outlined for GSWCF Council Dough

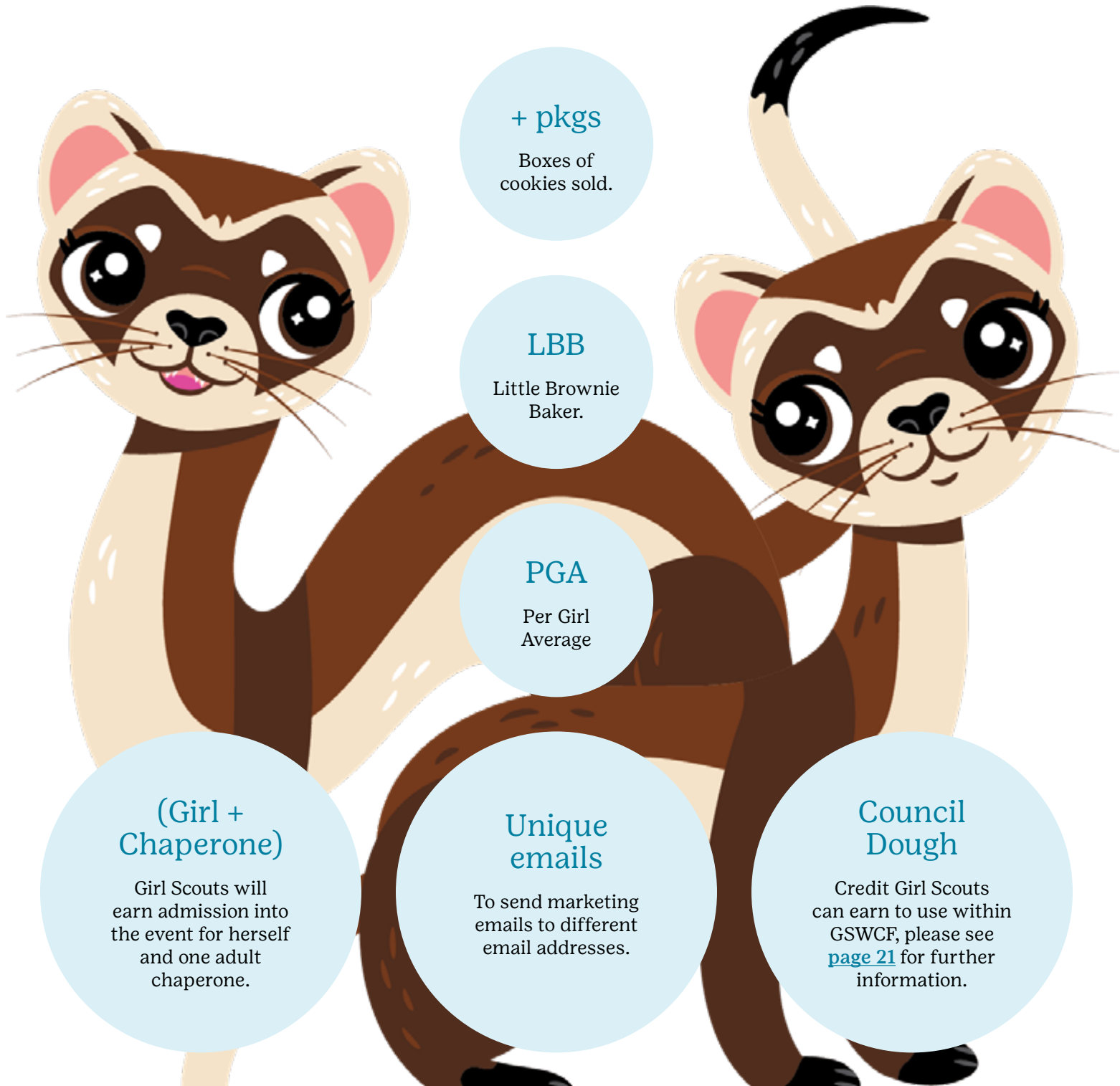

Meet the 2026 Cookie Mascot

Black-footed Ferret

Dens: Black-footed ferrets live in prairie dog dens in American grasslands and prairies.

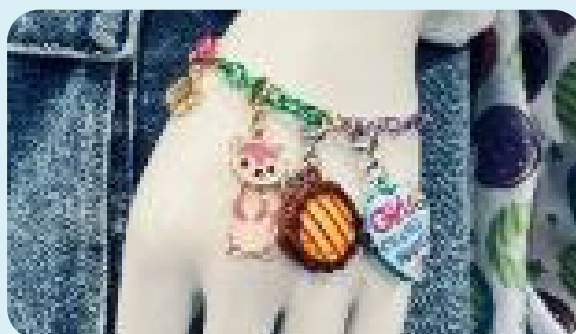

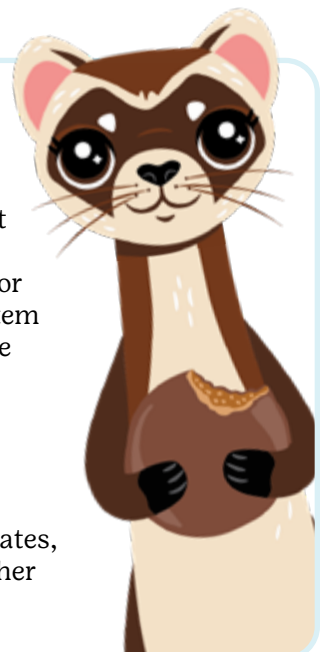
