Chigger - Oak - Skunk- Sleepy

- All 4 units have 7 cabins, screened unit house, bathhouse in unit, electric lights, outlets in screen room and a fire circle.*
- **Sleeping Capacity**: 28; can accommodate up to 4 people max per cabin.
- Suitable for: Brownies, Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

C.I.T.

- Dormitory with bunk beds, divided off leader's room, electricity, full kitchen, bathroom with showers, fire circle
- **Capacity:** 28; There are 12 bunk beds for girls that accommodate up to 24. The leaders sleep in a separate room that accommodates up to 4 people.
- **Suitable for:** All Girl Scout Levels
- MALES- Are NOT able to stay at this unit

Holiday House

- Single room, floor sleeping space with 20 cots available, electricity, full kitchen, bathroom with showers, fireplace and fire circle
- Capacity: 21
- **Suitable for:** All Girl Scout Levels
- **MALES-** Are **NOT** able to stay at this unit

Lady Bug

- 3 room building, 1 dormitory room with bunk beds (sleeps 24), 1 leader's sleeping room with 4 beds & separated bathroom, 1 full kitchen space, electricity, bathroom with showers, wrap around, screen porch and fire circle
- Capacity: 28
- **Suitable for:** All Girl Scout Levels
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

Pioneer

- Bring and pitch your own tent or hang your hammock tent on the hammock quad.
 When reserving this area at camp. This area includes picnic tables, water spigot and a fire ring, bathrooms and showers.*
- **Capacity**: 36
- Suitable for: Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

*This includes a counter top or tables to prepare food, kitchen sink with faucet and tables. You may also cook in this area with a propane stove at your request. A refrigerator is not provided in these areas. It is recommended to bring coolers

Archery Range

• Be on target and learn basic archery skills from signals to shooting a bull's-eye – you'll definitely make your mark. Requires certified archery instructor to facilitate. Please see safety activity check points for more information on certification requirements.

Challenge Course / Rock wall / Zip-line / Giant Swing

• The challenge course is an adventure program in outdoor recreation that features low wood team building elements, wall climbing on belay lines; 800ft zip line, and a giant swing. Access to this area is not permitted without a GSWCF facilitator, additional reservation and additional program fees are required. A \$100 deposit is required to book.

Day Shelter and Sports Court

- Day shelter includes a pavilion with two picnic tables, a basketball court, and open area games or activities.
- Capacity: 28 people

Lodge/Dining Hall

- The lodge features a fire place, tables with bench seating, chairs, industrial ice machine, restrooms and refrigerator for general use.
- A bridge for bridging ceremonies, large flag pole
- **Capacity**: 180 (Per Fire Code)
- **Kitchen** -Use of kitchen for encampments or special events requires a Certified Food Manager and all staff/volunteers must also have completed food handler training.

Lizard Craft Building

The Lizard craft building is a screened pavilion with picnic tables and benches, water, and electricity. The kiln is available for rent in addition to the craft space and must be run by a council approved facilitator.

Swimming Pool

- Ready to make a splash! Jump in to one of our pools. Swimming is great for fun, fitness and even teambuilding. Use of swimming pool requires 1 or more certified lifeguards and watchers. Please see safety activity check points for more information on certification requirements.
- Capacity: 66

Yurt

• The yurt is a traditional Mongolian tent with open air sides and roof with a skylight. This unique structure is an open space for programming. Why not relax and practice yoga or build kites to fly in the open fields of camp?

Log Cabin

- 1 Large open space, has AC, it has counters in a separated kitchen. The log cabin includes tables and chairs, electricity, full kitchen with an industrial ice machine for general use, bathroom, and fireplace and fire circle.
- **Capacity:** Day use-65. Sleeping-32. Sleeping cots are provided.
- Suitable for: All campers
- **MALES-** Are **NOT** able to stay at this unit

Owasee

- Tent camping; you must bring and pitch your own tents. This unit includes a picnic shelter with outlets, electric lights, fire circle and bathhouse with hot water.
- Capacity: 30
- Suitable for: Experienced Junior, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- MALES- Are able to stay at this unit

Platform Tents

- 7 platform tents, open unit shelter, fire circle and bathhouse
- Capacity: 28; 4 people max per tent
- **Suitable for:** Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

Treehouse

- 6 treehouses, 1 platform tent for leader's, open unit shelter, fire circle and bathhouse
- **Capacity:** 28; 4 people max per house. Adults may sleep in the treehouses. The leader's tent can accommodate up to 4 people max. When used by multiple troops, leaders must share the tent (2 per troop). Any additional adults must pitch a tent.
- **Suitable for:** Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- MALES- Are able to stay at this unit

Canoes-Kayak-Stand Up Paddle Boards

Low Cable course, Giant Swing and Low wooden course

 The static course and giant swing is an adventure program in outdoor recreation program that features low team building elements feature wood elements and static course elements as well as a giant swing. Access to this area is not permitted without a GSWCF facilitator, additional reservation and additional program fees are required.

Day Use Area (Potawatami)

- The perfect spot for running around or gazing at the stars. This is an ideal spot for group games or night time activities. Covered activity space with tables and chairs
- This includes a water spigot and an open area for games or activities. It is also adjacent to the Gaga pit & giant checkers board

Sleepover Room #1

- Available for Friday night sleepovers after 5:30pm
- Girls may use Girl Space area for games and activities until 10 am Saturday morning. Reservation includes floor sleeping (bring your own sleeping bag), two restrooms (no showers), DVD player, microwave, industrial ice machine, refrigerator, coffee maker and vending machines.
- Access to the Girl Zone.
- **Capacity:** 30

- This unit have 3 buildings with AC, and electricity. A screened downstairs area of each building includes counter tops, cabinets and equipment storage and 3 picnic tables. An outside staircase leads to the second story bunk room and bathroom. An outdoor grill and fire circle are available in each unit. Outdoor grill available. There is one fire circle per unit
- Capacity 40 people in each unit.
 - o Buildings 4,5,8,10,18, & 20 can accommodate 16.
 - o Buildings 3, 9, & 19 sleeps 12.
- Suitable for All campers
- **MALES** Are **NOT** able to stay at the cabin with the troop unless you rent a full cabin for them. You can make arrangements with the ranger for beds in the lodge area.

Kilo Hoku Unit

- This unit has 3 buildings with AC, and electricity. A screened downstairs area of each building includes picnic tables. An outside staircase leads to the second story covered porch, bunk room, and bathroom. An outdoor grill and fire circle is available at this unit.
- **Capacity:** 16 per building for a total of 48. **Suitable for** All campers
- **MALES** Are **NOT** able to stay at the cabin with the troop unless you rent a full cabin for them. You can make arrangements with the ranger for beds in the lodge area.

Staff Residence

- 5 room unit, with 2 sleeping rooms, with AC, bathroom with multiple stalls & showers, full kitchen, and dining room area
- Capacity: 12
- **Suitable for:** All age groups
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

BBQ Shelter (Bobby's Shelter)

• This covered pavilion has a grill and picnic benches. A flag pole, small playground and open play space are nearby.

Canoes-Kayak-Stand Up Paddle Boards

Explore the waters of camp by canoe, kayak, see through canoes or stand up paddle boards! Girls can learn canoeing skills including strokes, maneuvering and safety. Requires certified small craft safety instructor/lifeguard/qualified facilitator. Please see safety activity check points for more information on certification requirements

Climbing Tower /Zip-line

• The climbing tower is an adventure program in outdoor recreation that features 4 elements to climb on belay lines, 1 cargo net to climb with a self-lowering zip-line. Access to this area is not permitted without a GSWCF facilitator, additional reservation and additional program fees are required.

Classrooms

- This is an open room with chairs and tables. This area is used for meetings, or small activities.
 - o Classroom 1 can accommodate up to 15-20 people max.
 - o Classrooms 2 can accommodate up to 10-15 people max.

Crafts Building

- The craft building is a screened pavilion with picnic tables and benches, water, and electricity. A fully functioning kiln is available.
- Capacity 20

Dining Hall

- Large open room, tables with attached bench and stage for ceremonies
- Capacity: 144
- **Kitchen** Use of kitchen for encampments or special events requires a Food Manager/ServSafe Certification and all staff/volunteers must also have completed food handler training.

Kiln

• Want to play with clay? Create a unique work of art to be fired in the camp kilns! All girls can learn a new skill with projects geared specifically towards age and skill level. Projects can include hand building, pouring molds, bisque ware, painting & glazing. The kiln is available for rent in addition to the craft space and must be run by a council approved facilitator.

Marine Lab

- The marine science lab sits beside the tranquil mangroves on the Gulf of Mexico. This hands on classroom with tables and chairs is used for environmental studies and animal observation.
- Capacity 25

Sewing Room

- Cut, pin, and sew beautiful projects in our sewing room. Designed and built by girls in 2014, the Wai Lani sewing room is a great space for troops to complete sewn pieces. A large cutting table and 10 machines make this space ideal for troop projects.

Cricket

- 4 Cabins with 3 small rooms each, fire circle, unit house with a fireplace. A storage area, electricity and refrigerators. Bathhouse is attached to the unit house and offers flush toilets, hot showers and sinks.
- Capacity: 40; 10 people max per cabin.
- Suitable for: Brownies, Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- MALES- Are able to stay at this unit

Firefly

- This unit has a single bunk room accommodation layout with an in cabin bathroom. There are 3 buildings in the unit all with AC. A screened downstairs activity area at each building includes picnic tables. Each cabin has an outside staircase that leads to the second story covered porch. There is a breathtaking view of Lake Lenore from each porch. An outdoor grill and fire circle is available at this unit.
- **Capacity:** 16 per building for a total of 48.
- **Suitable for** All campers
- **MALES** Are **NOT** able to stay at the cabin with the troop unless you rent a full cabin for them.

Friendship Place

- Boasts 3 rooms of bunkbeds. It is heated & has AC as well as 1 ½ bathrooms with a hot shower and a full kitchen. A fire circle, picnic tables and a small play area is also available.
- Capacity: 15 people max.
- Suitable for: All grades
- **MALES-** Are able to stay at this unit

Gator

- 5 cabins, fire circle, a unit house with a fireplace and refrigerators. A storage area, tables and chairs and electricity. A separate bathhouse with sinks, flush toilets and hot showers. *One cabin is wheelchair accessible.*
- Capacity: 40; 8 people max per cabin.
- Suitable for: Brownies, Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- MALES- Are able to stay at this unit

Health Center

- Boasts 3 rooms of bunkbeds. It is heated & has AC as well as 2 bathrooms with a hot shower and a refrigerator and microwave.
- Capacity:15 people max.
- **Suitable for:** All grades
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

Homestead

- 8 mini barns, fire circle, bathhouse with flush toilets, hot showers and sinks. **There** is no electricity.
- Capacity: 32; 4 people per barn
- Suitable for: Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

Sleeping units cont.:

Oak Hammock

- Bring and pitch your own tents when reserving this area at camp. This includes a bathhouse with flush toilets, hot showers, and sinks. A fire circle and screened unit house is available. There is no electricity at this site.
- Capacity: 32
- **Suitable for:** Experienced Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit

Stuart's Horseshoe Meadows

- 4 sleeping room dormitory style building with bunk beds, electricity, fire circle and indoor fireplace. Bathrooms with hot showers, sinks and flush toilets. A full kitchen with two refrigerators, an industrial ice machine and activity room with a stage. Horseshoe Meadows also boasts an observation tower.
- Horseshoe Meadow #1 sleeps 16, #2 sleeps 18 (upstairs), #3 sleeps 8, #4 sleeps10 (upstairs)
- Capacity: 52
- Suitable for: All campers
- **MALES** Are able to stay at this unit. There is a small room for 2 just for males

Griffin Nature Center

- The Griffin Nature Center sits among the trees. This atrium has a library, conference room, laboratory/ classroom with tables and stools, bathroom, mini size-refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, sink, floor mattresses and large wrap around porch with benches. This center is used for environmental studies and animal observation. The conference room and classroom can also be rented for community meetings. Fire circle nearby. This unit is booked in 3 hour slots for the day use or a single overnight stay.
- **Capacity:** Day Use-32 or Single Overnight stay-20

Lodge/ Dining Hall

- Large, indoor dining hall with tables and chairs, fans, restrooms and screened porch. This unit is used for day use, council girl events, meetings, learning opportunities and resident camp.
- Capacity: 144
- **Kitchen** Use of kitchen for encampments or special events requires a Certified Food Manager and all staff/volunteers must also have completed food handler training.

Swimming Pool

- Ready to make a splash! Jump in to one of our pools. Swimming is great for fun, fitness and even teambuilding. Use of swimming pool requires 1 or more certified lifeguards and watchers. Please see safety activity check points for more information on certification requirements.
- **Capacity** 90 person max. Certified Lifeguard require to use
