Bronze Award FAQ

Who can earn the Bronze Award? Who helps?

Only Girl Scout Juniors (4th & 5th Grade) can earn their Bronze Award
The Girl Scout Advisor is a trusted adult that will help with the Girl Scout side of the project (project plan, paperwork, and project implementation). The GS Advisor can be a troop leader, troop helper, caregiver or another registered Girl Scout member.

What is a Bronze Award?

It all starts here. Juniors can decide to go solo and recruit others to help, or team up with other Girl Scout Juniors to explore their community, discover a need or issue they care about and work together to address it. It's a chance to create a plan and make an impact on the community they live in.

When are the important dates?

March 1:

All reports submitted by this date will be included in that year's ceremony. Reports submitted after this date will be included in the following year's ceremony.

September 30:

All final reports due following the Girl Scout's 5th Grade year

Where is a Bronze Award completed?

Girls will explore their community and the issues around to decide where they will take action. Projects done at camp or benefitting Girl Scouts require council preapproval. This must be completed prior to starting the project.

Why earn the Bronze Award?

The Bronze Award is a great way for Girl Scouts to make a difference in their community while learning important life skills. It helps girls:

- Become leaders by working together to plan and carry out a project.
- Solve problems by thinking creatively and finding ways to help others.
- Work as a team and learn how to communicate and cooperate.
- Care about their community and understand how they can make it better.
- Build confidence by seeing the impact of their hard work.

 - 1 Junior Leadership Award

- Make a plan of action
