



SODA BOTTLE COMPOSTING

What you will need:

- Empty 2 Liter Soda Bottle
- Soil, dead leaves, grass, pinecones, and/or newspaper
- Spoiled produce or peels from eaten bananas, or vegetable stems
- Scissors
- Water

Instructions:

1. Cut the top off of an empty soda bottle, rinse it out completely and take off the labeling
2. Make a of layer soil or other ground materials you found at the bottom of the bottle
3. Alternate layers of food materials and ground materials until the bottle is filled
4. When the bottle is full add water to start composting (just enough to get the ingredients in the bottle damp all the way through)
5. Let your compost sit outside in a spot where it will get plenty of sunlight and won't tip over for 2 weeks
6. Check your compost bottle frequently and record any changes that you see
