

# Flora Show Week 2 Craft



## Flora Ornament

### Supplies

- Light Pink Yarn
- Fork
- Plastic Yarn Needle
- Scissors
- Glue (hot glue is recommended)
- 1 small popsicle stick
- 2 small pink feathers
- 2 small googly eyes
- Light Pink felt or foam (leftover from week 1)
- Black felt or foam (leftover from week 1)

### Instructions

#### To make a Pom Pom

- Step 1: Wrap the yarn around the prongs of the fork about 50 times.
- Step 2: Be sure to leave a slight gap at the base of the prongs for the next step.
- Step 3: Once wrapping is complete, cut the end of the yarn.
- Step 4: Thread a piece of yarn (approx. 12 inches) through your yarn needle, leaving one end of the yarn longer than the other end.
- Step 5: Thread your need through the bottom of the middle prong.
- Step 6: Wrap it up and around and then wrap it again, pulling very tight.
- Step 7: Wrapping it around the center twice will allow you to get a nice and tight center.
- Step 8: Unthread the yarn from the needle, remove the yarn ball from the fork.
- Step 9: Tie a knot but do not cut the ends, you will use these for hanging the ornament.
- Step 10: Cut the loops on each side and trim ends to make the pom pom more rounded.

#### Constructing your Flora

- Step 1: Cut a 1" piece of regular sized popsicle stick and 1" square piece of pink felt.
- Step 2: Wrap the pink felt around the popsicle stick, secure with hot glue.
- Step 3: Hot glue a pom pom to each end of the popsicle stick.
- Step 4: Cut a beak shape out of black felt or foam.
- Step 5: Glue two small googly eyes above the beak.
- Step 6: Glue the beak onto the center of one of the 'top' pom pom.
- Step 7: Glue two small pieces of feather to the 'bottom' pom pom, with one on each side.
